### **Dear Scholarship Applicant:**

The objective of the Kane County Fair scholarship program is to assist 4-H members pursuing higher education. There will be as many as three (3) scholarships awarded this summer.

The Kane County Fair scholarships will be in the amount of \$3000.00 each payable over 4 years, in installments of \$750.00. The scholarships are available to high school seniors who will graduate in this school year. You must also be a current member of 4-H and have exhibited at the Kane County Fair in at least one of the last two years.

Checks will be made payable to the college or university that the scholarship winner will be attending. For school years 2 through 4 the scholarship winner must prove that they are registered (in school) to receive funds for that year.

Each application for scholarship will be reviewed and judged by the Fair selection committee. The scholarships will be awarded to students pursuing higher education in any field.

The deadline for scholarship applications will be April 1. Any application that is mailed must be postmarked no later than April 1. The Fair scholarship application is available at the fair office, as well as, on our web page at <a href="www.kanecountyfair.com">www.kanecountyfair.com</a>. Please call the fair office to verify receipt of your application at 630 584 6926. Scholarship winner(s) will be announced on April 30<sup>th</sup>. #### KANE COUNTY FAIR SCHOLARSHIP POLICIES

- 1. Scholarship funds provided will be paid directly to the school as a part of the tuition payment. Scholarships can be used for fall, spring or summer semester tuition during the school year immediately following the individual's selection as a scholarship winner. If the student does not use the scholarship within the year, the scholarship is forfeited; Additionally if the student does not continue their education for the full four years the remainder of the scholarship is forfeited.
- 2. Kane County Fair Scholarship recipients must remain full time students carrying at least 12 hours.
- 3. The selection committee will use a standardized grading scale, which incorporates a points system when evaluating scholarship applications. Scholarships will be awarded to students according to points scored, satisfying application criteria and need.
- 4. The overall purpose of the Kane County Fair Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to high quality 4-H members who wish to continue their education by attending a college or university.
- 5. To receive a scholarship you are required to be a current 4-H member who has exhibited at the Kane County Fair in at least one of the last two years and are graduating from high school this school year.

- 3) ESSAY
- 4) FINANCIAL NEED
- 5) REFERENCES
- 6) EXCEPTIONAL CONSIDERATION: ie This could include parent's occupation, unusual family situations, exceptional leadership involvement, etc.

The highest rated student will receive the Kane County Fair Scholarship.
